

Telegrafenberg

On the top of the "Fuchsberg" there is an impressive view over extensive orchards, the "Plessower See" and the wonderful landscape of the "Havelseen". On the "Fuchsberg" – also known as the "Telegrafenberg" – there is a replica of a signal mast with three pairs of wings for the optical telegraphy of a telegraph station. At that time, the telegraphists brought the wings in different positions to transmit numbers and letters. The original "Station Nummer 5" with a building and the signal mast was constructed in 1832. A picnic

in the midst of wonderful nature is very worthwhile.

At the edge of the panorama path "Werderobst" you can admire a floor fruit area newly laid out according to historical role models and one of the biggest coherent sweet cherrie plantations in Germany. Along this path are a lot of nesting aids for birds and insect



hotels. It shows, how the city of Werder (Havel) takes care an ecological management of the green strips: an impressive variety of species has developed at the panorama path.

If you travel a few kilometers further from Derwitz, you will reach the station at Groß Kreutz. From there, you can take the "Regionalexpress" 1 back to Werder (Havel).

## Panorama path "Werderobst"

... discover the cultural landscape, walking or by bike

## Follow the red apple and experience an unforgettable bike or hiking tour at the "Panoramaweg Werderobst" – in any season.

As the name "Panoramaweg" suggests, during the trip the beauty of our historical and contamporary cultural landscape becomes accessible. Without doubt, this route is one of the most beautiful bike and walking trails around our "Blütenstadt am Wasser" Werder (Havel). There is also a connection to the Havel bike trail.

The signposts show you a red apple with an apple blossom on a dark green background with the inscription "Panoramaweg Werderobst". Many signs additionally give you evidence about the nearby fruit farms or the sights.

The route takes us trought the famous "Obstkammer Berlins" the fruits chamber of Berlin. Particularly in spring, during the flowering season, the route is very attractive. Then the "Baumblütenfest", the widely known tree blossom festival takes place.

Not only the character of the traditionell orchards can be experienced, as well as the many sights of the region. The route which is classified as "moderate" stretches for around 15 km and starts in Petzow with the former palace, the "Schinkelkirche" and the "Lennépark". Along the "Glindower See" you can discover the "Glindower Alps" as well as the brick museum next to the brick factory with the old reconstructed Hoffmanschen circular kiln. We continue along extensive orchards and the Lilienthalmonument on the "Derwitzer Mühlenberg".

Summer and autumn, the "Glindower Platte" is worth a visit. Pure air, riped fruit everywhere – follow signs to the traditional orchards that often directly sell their products. In some places, you can have a break, harvest some seasonal fruit and buy local products.
